Associate Objects Conservator

The Cleveland Museum of Art ([www.clevelandart.org](http://www.clevelandart.org) <[www.clevelandart.org](http://www.clevelandart.org)> ) is seeking a full-time Object Conservator at the Associate or Senior/full level. This position is available July 1 2008. The position will report to the Chief Conservator and will head the Museum's object lab in its newly constructed conservation facility while the Museum enters the second phase of a major expansion and renovation project. The new conservation facilities comprises a total of 135,000 square feet and includes paper, painting, textile and Asian painting labs as well as an analytical lab and imaging and conservation preparatory studios.

The successful candidate will work with various departments and staff members within the institution to care for the Museum's object-based collections -- a comprehensive range of objects from the Americas, Europe and Asia and from ancient to contemporary art. Close collaboration with the curatorial department and other members of the conservation department is essential. Major responsibilities include the examination, analysis, documentation and treatment of objects for exhibition, loan and acquisition. The successful candidate will have travel opportunities as they relate functions of the department and will participate in museum wide preservation activities including gallery monitoring and collection maintenance. The successful candidate will be responsible for supervising junior staff member and fellows/interns.

Candidates must be a graduate of a recognized conservation training program and have at least five years of post-graduate experience working in object conservation. Examples of research and writing ability as well as English language skills are required. The position also requires strong organizational skills and the ability to work independently as well as in a team-oriented environment. The applicant should have excellent hand skills and visual acuity.
